<b>Learning Objectives</b>	To understand the importance in masks throughout history and in modern times. To start designing their own masks with an explanation as to why and what for and to upkeep a learning diary.
<b>Materials</b>	Planning diary BIC® Kids Learner Pen Twist BIC® Kids Evolutions Ecolutions Colouring Pencils 
<b>Teacher Prep</b>	
Print out the planning diary and mask information and Venn diagrams from previous lessons.	
<b>Lesson</b>	
<p><b>Starter:</b> 1) Recap on the last lesson about masks and how they're used for re-using the Venn diagrams. (10 minutes)</p> <p><b>Main activity:</b> 1) Table activity: Give pupils the planning diary for the design of the mask, this lesson is only to fill out the first page of the plan (design criteria &amp; to draw ideas), make realistic plans to achieve their aims. (10 minutes).</p> <p><b>Conclusion:</b> 1) Ask pupils to one by one to give a few words on what their masks are going to be and why they have chosen that, try and stay away from superhero and toy masks and try to get the pupils to focus on masks of use.</p>
